Dennis Chiodini inquired about the Woodson Road Park Tennis Court Asphalt perimeter extension if it will happen this spring. The Parks Director expressed that the Street Director stated yes it will happen this Spring 2019.

Discussion took place about an online petition regarding residents wanting a skate park.

Robert Schuetz motioned to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Donna Dill.
