Robert Schuetz made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 25, 2016 meeting. Motion was seconded by all. Motion approved 6 -0.

Robert Schuetz thanked the City of St Ann and the Community Center staff for the tour of the St Ann Community Center. Matt, the Rec Aid was very knowledgeable in his presentation and the Overland Parks Commission appreciates his time.

Park Report presented by Erin Willey.

Discussion took place about Woodson Road Park in regards to the Dog Park and if the Parks Director had heard of any negative comments about the use of the park. The Parks Director stated that there were a few concerns regarding dog handlers picking up after their dogs the past few months and the amount of standing water in the play areas after a good downpour of rain. The Parks Dept. can issue a reminder to all dog park members regarding the removal of pet waste in the next round of mailings regarding the renewal of Dog Park Memberships for the 2016-17 season. Dog Park Members are able to apply for the 2016-17 season starting April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016.

Discussion took place about Legion Park regarding the large event that was held up there this past weekend.

Discussion took place about Woodson Road Park regarding the south side of the tennis courts and the sod that is being laid down. This area is beyond the City's property line and belongs to the company next to the Tennis Courts.

Robert Schuetz thanked Karen Seal and Dennis Chiodini for attending and helping at the Trash Bash; in addition to Kent Funkhouser for attending and helping at the Kids Easter Egg Hunt. Both events took place on March 19<sup>th</sup> at the same time.

Robert Schuetz informed the Parks Commission that at the last City Council Meeting that he would be reaching out to the individual who owns Game Haven in Overland to discuss their ideas about a wanting to install a Green House at Wild Acres Park or Legion Park. Robert Schuetz will contact the individual and get more information.

Discussion took place about the next Municipal Park Grant regarding Parks Commissions recommendation to apply it towards the replacement of Mort Jacobs Park Playground. The Parks Director explained that this decision has not been approved by the City Council yet due to two playgrounds being removed at the same time. The Parks Dept hopes to have information gathered to present to the Council for discussion sometime after the next City Council Meeting.
