Discussion took place about Brooks Park in regards to the bridge.

Donna Dill made a motion to recommend that the City Council apply for a County Municipal Grant in 2017 for Legion Park. Motion was seconded by Donna Lewis. Motion was tabled for a more in depth discussion in September.

Discussion took place about inspections in regards to grant projects having sufficient inspections as the project is taking place to ensure proper installation.

The Parks Commission requested that a copy of the Revised Parks Master Plan of Legion Park be given to the two newest commission members.

Discussion took place about Norman Myers Park in regards to replacing the boarded window with a glass window.

Discussion took place about dogs in regards to the admittance of dogs in Overland Parks. Erin Willey stated that dogs are permitted in the majority of Overland Parks with the exception of Wild Acres Park. Only Service dogs are permitted at Wild

Acres Park. All dogs must be leashed at all times, accompanied by an owner, and the owner is required to pick up after their dog in the parks.

Discussion took place about the skate park idea in regards to a possible location. Karen Seal and Donna Lewis left contact info for the owner of 2428 Woodson Road to inquire about the green space behind the building being used for a possible skate park location in the future.

Dennis Chiodini made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Motion was seconded by Donna Lewis. Motion approved 8-0.
