

Minutes of the Parks and Recreation Commission of the City of Overland held on July 29, 2021

Amy Foulks made a motion to approve the revised minutes of the May 27, 2021 meeting. Motion was seconded by Donna Dill. Motion approved 3-0.

Donna Dill made a motion to approve the minutes of the June 24, 2021 meeting. Motion was seconded by Amy Foulks. Motion approved 3-0.

Park Report presented by Parks & Recreation Director, Erin Willey.

Discussion took place about Wild Acres Park, in regards to Parking Lot Bingo. Donna Dill mentioned her list of volunteers included Robert Schuetz and Councilman Larry Bennett to Park Cars, Amy Foulks to call out BINGO numbers and check card numbers, and that she needed one more volunteer to help pass out prizes. It was stated that some prizes have been donated, but that she will need about 10 more for the event.

Discussion took place about Norman Myers Park, in regards to the next Concert in the Park. Date requested is Wednesday September 15, 2021 from 7-9 pm and featuring the band called SPIN. They have agreed to do the event for \$250 for 2 hours of live music play time. Advertisement Yard Signs will need new sticker decals with the new date ordered and updated. Food Trucks would be preferred and Donna Dill is looking for companies that may be interested. Frequency of the Concert was indicated to be done every month and Bingo every other month. Donna Dill mentioned that she would like to see the expenses for the band for the Concert in the Park Events to come out of the General Fund instead of the Parks Fund due to the General Fund receiving the Food Truck Fee. Due to the Concert in the Park being a Park Special Event, expenses are currently being taken from the Park Fund, as approved by the City Council.

Amy Foulks motioned to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by Robert Schuetz. Motion approved.
