Discussion took place about Legion Park Grant in regards to how far along the construction process is coming. Field lights are up and dirt has been placed.

Jared Shadley inquired about when the construction process would be completed. Bob Schuetz commented that the rain could affect that process.

Discussion took place about vandalism that took place at Brooks Park in the bathrooms. Repairs have been completed and bathrooms are opened again. Robert Schuetz suggested a Meet & Greet take place at Brooks Parks as a way of socializing with residents and kids in the neighborhood.

Donna Dill motioned Meet & Greet at Brooks Park, Amy Foulks seconded it. Motion approved 7-0.

Discussion took place about the Parking Lot extension at the Overland Community Center. Sidewalk has been completed and new gate for trash bins installed.

Discussion took place about the fish stocking for the Kid's Fishing Derby as well as the increase pricing for fishing licenses and other fees that the Missouri Department of Conservation are planning to increase for year 2020.

Discussion took place about pricing for memberships, room rentals, and park pavilion rentals. All suggested that room rentals should increase by \$5 and park pavilion rentals should increase by \$10.

Discussion took place about the amount of times Wild Acres Banquet Hall is being donated.

Robert Schuetz motioned to adjourn the meeting. The motion was seconded by all. Motion approved.
