Bring all of the following documents to the event to apply for assistance:

- Recent home energy bill (electric, natural gas, home heating oil or propane).
- Copies of social security cards for all household members and their birth dates. (If your household currently receives food stamps, only the social security numbers and birth dates are required.)
- Copies of income documentation such as paystubs (for the previous month), current award letters or current pension statements. (If your household currently receives food stamps, income documentation is not required.)

CAASTLC's costs for participating in this event are funded 100% at \$1,000 with federal funds received from the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services provided by the Missouri Department of Social Services.
